### "SmartNets – Collaborative development and production of knowledge-intensive products and services"



You are cordially invited to participate in the workshop entitled "SmartNets – Collaborative development and production of knowledge-intensive products and services" in the International Conference on Interoperability for Enterprise Systems and Applications (I-ESA) 2014.

I-ESA is established as the major event addressing Enterprise Interoperability and the official conference of Virtual Laboratory for Enterprise Interoperability (INTEROP-VLab) with the sponsorship of the International Federation for Information Processing (IFIP) and the International Federation of Automatic Control (IFAC).

The Workshop will take place in Albi (France) on 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> March 2014.

#### **Workshop Scope:**

**Innovative knowledge-intensive products, processes and services** are the basis for increasing the competitiveness of European industry. **Cross-sectoral collaboration** is beyond controversy one of the most powerful approaches to deal with the growing complexity and limited timeframe for the realization of such innovations. The workshop will follow the **idea of Smart Networks** which is promoting an organisational, ICT and knowledge perspective on collaboration. This model is especially **suited for collaborative innovation**.

For the half-day workshop, six papers are targeted. Each paper should provide significant insights into collaboration from one or several perspectives of the Smart Networking model: Organisational networking, ICT networking and/or knowledge networking. We also seek for balance between beyond-state-of-the-art research contributions and application-oriented research.

The following is a non-exhaustive list of topics that fit in the framework of the proposed workshop:

- Collaborative Networks and Networking Capabilities
- Collaborative Product-Service Development and Provisioning
- Business Models for/in Ecosystems
- Business Interoperability in Ecosystems
- Knowledge and Competences in Networks
- Architectures and Modelling for Enterprise Interoperability
- Platforms and Services for Enterprise Interoperability

#### ***Workshop Format***

- Speakers: ca. 6
- Presentations: from the above topics.
- Duration (provisional, depending on total time allocated in programme): two time slots, each comprising three presentations à 20 minutes and a 30 minute moderated discussion amongst all participants in which key issues of the paper contribution will be debated, extended and further research work pointed out

#### ***Paper Submission***

Papers must be in English, describe original work and must follow the HERMES eng-guidelines for authors. A package with formatting instructions for Workshop papers (max. length: 6 pages) and a MS Word template are available in the section "Paper submission" at [www.i-esa.org](http://www.i-esa.org).

The Workshop Paper submission **deadline is December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2013**.

A peer-review process has been established to evaluate and assess the submitted papers to ensure high quality and complementary of contributions. Please submit your Workshop paper directly to the workshop chair.
